





Located on 34 scenic acres in Mt. Vernon, NY, the Wartburg campus offers a full spectrum of senior living options – from private townhomes rich with amenities to award-winning nursing home care. Our residents enjoy:

1870

The Moller Building, the first new construction on campus, is completed. Through generous donations from Peter Moller and John Roebling, builder of the Brooklyn Bridge, this stone edifice is built to house the orphans, the director and his family and all administrative and support services.



1882

Board President Charles Hauselt donates \$5,000 to fund the construction of a chapel at Wartburg. The building will also serve as a classroom for the orphans.

Jodie: Clinical Nutrition Manager

Rousheda: I am a Licensed Practical Nurse **Wilson:** Registered Dietitian Manager

Why did you choose to work at Wartburg?

Jodie: My personal preference is to work with Long-Term Care Residents, and I've always been professionally aware of how highly regarded the Wartburg staff and services are.

Rousheda: I have been working at Wartburg for 5 years as a certified nurse assistant. It feels good to leave your home in the mornings knowing that you are heading to a place where the staff is respectful, compassionate, approachable and love the work they do; that is why I chose to stay and continue my nursing profession here.

Wilson: I was referred by two of my classmates who interned here. They only spoke great things about Wartburg.

How does your work make an impact on the population Wartburg serves?

Jodie: Optimal nutrient intake aids in healing, helps to prevent skin breakdown, as well as prevents or reverses malnutrition – all risks our resident population faces.

Rousheda: My work as an LPN will impact this population that I serve because of the extensive caring background I have obtained over the years as a CNA. I am very familiar with the culture, philosophy and the mission of Wartburg, and I love it all because it has helped to make me who I am today.

Wilson: I make sure my residents meet their energy requirements, including protein intake as well as their meal preferences. In addition, I provide help with a range of medical nutrition therapies (MNT), which are nutrition plans used to treat specific medical conditions.

The New Living Center will be a state-of-the-art facility that will bring resources and support to those affected by Alzheimer's and dementia related diseases. The building will consist of 64 beds total, made up of 32 single suites and 32 companion suites, with 16 beds per household. It will include an event space, music therapy room and designated areas for service, management, staff and support spaces.

Uncompensated Care

The Skilled Nursing Facility, Licensed Home Care and Adult Day Care programs accept all patients regardless of their ability to pay or payer source. Many of the seniors we serve live at or below the poverty line and are eligible for Medicaid, which through its established rates reimburses Wartburg for providing the care. However, in many cases this reimbursement is below the actual cost incurred. The cost of uncompensated care is as follows:
